Lilydale Emergency Procedure – Stay or Go?



If an emergency occurs at BHI all of the emergency management protocols are based around the safety our people and the decision to Stay or Go. All incidents will be managed by the Chief Warden and the Warden Team (Emergency Control Organisation) or the Critical Incident Management Team. In relation to Stay or Go, there are three possible options:

STAY – Shelter in place	STAY – Lockdown (Code Black)	GO – Evacuate
A precaution aimed to keep people safe while remaining indoors.	A precaution in response to a threat to BHI or the surrounding area. During a lockdown no one is allowed to enter or exit the building.	The process of evacuating one or all buildings of occupants in response to an emergency.

Message Beep Beep Whoop Whoop will be communicated via Emergency Warning and Intercommunication system (EWIS) , and is authorised by Chief Warden.
