

GETTING STARTED CHECKLIST

If you are a newly enrolled student, the following checklist may be helpful to you in setting yourself up for study success. If you need any assistance with any of the following – Student Life are here to help.

1) Travel and Transport

- Think about how you plan to travel to and from campus. Explore [public transport](#) options or [car parking](#) availability.
- If you will be driving to campus, obtain a parking permit from the Facilities Office & download the PayStay parking app
- If eligible, obtain a Transport Victoria Tertiary Student ID which enables you to travel on a Concession Myki:

2) Get your tech sorted!

- Ensure you have set up the [free Student WIFI](#) on your devices
- Set up [Microsoft Teams](#) and familiarise yourself with the use of this program
- Ensure that your [BHI Student Email](#) is set up, and establish a habit of regularly checking this. If you feel you may forget – you might want to instead forward this to your regular email address.
- Set up [Office 365](#)

3) Next steps

- Set up a designated study space at home or consider an alternative location (such as your campus or public library) if your home environment is not conducive to study.
- Investigate the [library](#) at your campus and make sure you are familiar with borrowing, printing and photocopying processes
- Check if you have the required textbooks, uniform and course materials
- Make sure you know how to contact your teachers and Course Coordinator
- Set up your class timetable in a calendar
- Enter the due dates for assessments in the same calendar
- Use a weekly planner and allocate blocks of time (outside of class hours) for study and assignments
- Download any useful study apps
