What is AI?

Generative AI tools such as ChatGPT, Bard and other chatbots can be used to assist in many ways to create, analyse, synthesise, refine and modify text, images, music and other forms of communication.

DO

- Explore AI and what it can do.
- Check reliability and currency of AI tool generated responses.
- Observe any restrictions on the use of AI imposed by your teacher.
- Acknowledge use of AI tools as per referencing guidelines.
- Select the checkbox to acknowledge the work is your own when submitting your assessment online.
- Learn about academic integrity in class or through your library website.
- Ask your teacher or student support services for advice if unsure about the use of AI.
- Use AI tools in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct and Academic Integrity Policy and Procedure.

DON'T

- Copy and paste AI generated responses and present it as your own writing
- Breach any restrictions on the use of AI set by your teacher.
- Provide any of your personal or confidential information to an AI tool.
- Infringe copyright or other intellectual property rights.
